New platform to help job seekers

CHENNAI: `The Knowledge Capital', a non-profit organisation, has been floated by the founders of Tranquilmoney Inc, US and their colleagues in US and India with a view to create an online and offline platform to help job seekers.

The organisation has two projects - an institutional effort to create a viable channel for "securitising" adult vocational training loans and a grassroots effort to help fund individuals and groups that conduct various kinds of re-training of the workforce on a non-profit basis.

Co-founder of the Knowledge Capital project and chairman Tranquilmoney Inc, Karun Philip, said the first project envisages working with major institutions to increase liquidity for vocational training loans while the grassroots project will try to help those who are already doing re-training, on a non-profit basis.

"The ultimate aim of the Knowledge Capital project is to help people who invest in people," he said adding the organisation through its website <http://www.k-capital.com> will use internet to allow people around the world to sign up and physically meet other like-minded individuals in their city or town who are interested in this approach.
